

In-Ground and Attached Flagpoles

Flag holders/poles that attach to the main structure are permitted without prior ARC approval. (Please read "Note" at bottom of guideline)

In ground flagpoles must be approved by the ARC committee to determine location, size, construction material and permanence. Flagpoles must meet the following guidelines prior to submitting requests for ARC approval.

- 1. Flagpoles must be constructed of either steel or aircraft aluminum construction
- 2. Flagpoles must not exceed 20' in height from the ground.
- 3. Flags displayed must be maintained and not in a state of disrepair, e.g.: frayed, faded or torn.

* NOTE: It is requested that all flags be flown in a respectful manner, and that all customs and courtesies regarding our national and state colors be observed. These guidelines can be found under United States Code Title 36 Chapter 10, also known as the Flag Code when applied to the United States Flag and Title 10 Chapter 1 SECTION 10-1-160 of South Carolina in regards to the flying of the State Flag.
