News from the Board

Thank you to everyone whom returned their proxies and/or came out to our annual meeting on Thursday October 16th. Your newly elected Board of Directors is listed below. In addition to electing a new board, the following proposed ByLaw changes were voted on and approved by majority vote: Elimination of the Nominating committee, Elimination for the need for financial audit each year, Elimination of the wording that books and records need to be kept in Dorchester County, and a change in term limit language for the Board of Directors to allow for staggered terms. The ByLaw amendment will be drafted by our lawyer and submitted to the county for filing. Once we have the finalized document, it will be placed on our website and sent to all homeowner's. On another but similar note, we still need residents to turn in ballots for changes to the covenants. If you have not returned yours, please do so as soon as possible. We need a 75% vote to change covenants and those votes were not covered by the proxy you may have completed for the annual meeting. The covenant review committee will continue to work towards getting the needed ballots for these changes between now and the end of the year.

Compliance Corner

As you may know, compliance is based on the neighborhood covenants and many of our current covenants are outdated or unclear as they are written. Our covenant committee worked hard this year to put together recommendations for covenant changes. Homeowners received the change information and ballot in the mail along with the annual meeting information. To change the covenants, we need 75% of the homeowners to return the ballot. That is 321 homes. So far we have received 114 ballots so we need an additional 207. We will continue to work hard at collecting these ballots between now and the end of the year in hopes that the changes can be made sooner rather than later. 
