The BOD has been busy at work this last month as we start to prep for the end of our terms. As many of you know, we have had behavioral issues at the pool resulting in the implementation of a Teenager Authorization Form. Without this form on file, teenagers ages 14–18 will not be allowed into the pool even if they have a key fob. Children 13 and under are not allowed at the pool without a responsible adult there with them.

The Covenant Review Committee worked hard for over a year to come up with recommendations to the community for changes to our current covenants. Covenants are the rules that the community is governed by and can not be changed without a vote by 75% of the community. They have been working over the last year to get homeowners to complete their ballots and we are still about 200 short. Please help us wrap up this process by turning in your ballot before September 30th, 2018.

Nominations and elections, though a few months off still, are coming up quickly. The majority of the current board has expressed that they will not be re-running. Please consider volunteering for the upcoming board and continuing the hard work that we have put in over the last two years. The August newsletter will outline the timeline and process to get your name on the ballot.
