

## MAILBOXES

The following specifications are for all mailboxes throughout the Myers Mill Community.

Mailboxes must be well maintained. Having no rust or loose or broken parts. It is recommended by USPS guidelines to perform maintenance on your mailbox annually due to harsh weather and sun damage.

Changes to mailboxes - provided they meet these specifications - do not need Board or ARC approval. Prior to any replacement or repair, please review the following guidelines:

- Maximum Size 12H x 12W x 20D inches
- Materials:
  - Box - Metal or composite material (as shown in picture 1 below)
  - Post: Wood
- Color: ■ Box: Black
  - Post: Black
- Mailbox post should be a post, no less than 4ft, and no more than 5ft from the ground to the top (not including the cap as shown in picture 2 below) and placed as space allows so that the mailbox can be easily accessed from the mail delivery vehicle.
- Mailbox Post Cap: Copper and Black caps are approved (see example in picture 3 below). Anything other than that will need ARC approval prior to installation.
- Mailboxes with a locking mechanism are allowed provided they meet all other specifications in this document (check with the USPS on their guidelines). Mailboxes may have locking mechanisms and front and rear access.
- Post must be PLUMB to ground, well maintained with limited wear and tear and sun damage, and securely attached to the ground.
- Numbers must be adhesive and placed on the right side and front of the box. Placing it on the left side in addition to the right side and front is acceptable.
